For the State of New Mexico

Since 1994, \$64,921,443 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of New Mexico

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 791 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in New Mexico.
- 107 local and state law enforcement agencies in New Mexico have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$9,321,816 has been awarded to add 86 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout New Mexico.
- \$3,388,238 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of New Mexico fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
